Bluntisham Parish Footpaths

- **B1** Starts opposite the bungalow near Low Wood Farm on the A1123. The path takes you to the Hanson gravel works where it joins up with Needingworth footpath 1. This links to Needingworth footpath which will take you to the Ouse Valley Way **B16** where you can walk along the riverbank and back to the village via **B3**.
- **B2** This is a fork off **B1** and connects to a different point on **B16** Ouse Valley Way, it will also bring you back via **B3**.
- **B3** Starts near the bus shelter on the main road through the village and cuts down to the river. It is an official part of the Pathfinder Way and an official link path to The Ouse Valley Way **B13**.
- **B4** This connects Wood End to the A1123. You can access it from Wood End by going down Nobles Lane or from the A1123 through the gate by the old railway bridge as you leave the village heading towards Needingworth.
- **B5 & 6** Meeting Walk which runs through the centre of the village connecting the High Street to Hollidays Road, East Street and Block Hill.
- **B8** This starts at the end of Mill Lane and connects up with Earith footpaths 1 & 2 which take you to the main Bluntisham-Earith road or to join up with Colne Road, Earith.
- **B9** This is a short path on the Parish boundary with Colne, it is currently inaccessible to the public without climbing gates and fences.
- **B13 &B16** these paths are part of the official Ouse Valley Way and Pathfinder Way walks.
